The table shows the results of multivariable logistic regression analysis, with the dependent variable Very Poorly Controlled asthma (ACT Score 5-15). Other variables entered into the model that were not significant were: age group, education level, SEIFA category (socioeconomic disadvantage) and age at first diagnosis of asthma. The overall fit of the final model was .047 for Cox & Snell R Square and .071 for Nagelkerke R Square.
